3. Aptitude Test

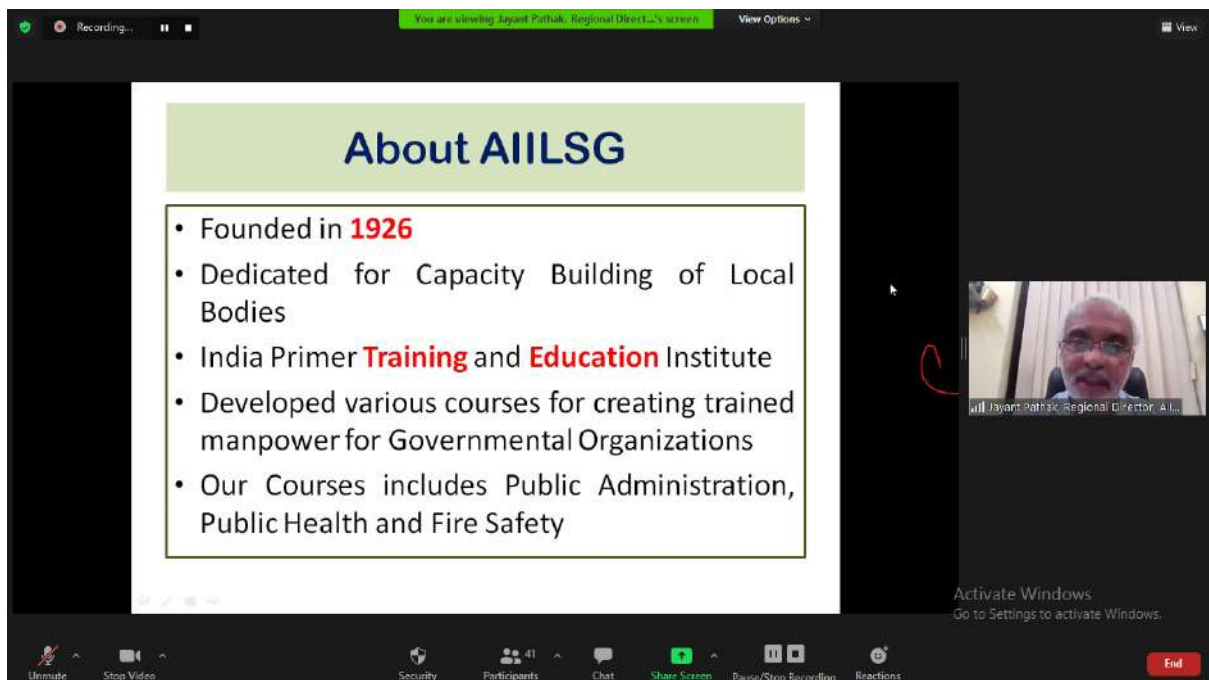

7. "SANKALP PROGRAM" for selected 21 students

A second **zoom meeting** ("SANKALP PROGRAM") was arranged on 7th Feb 2021 at 11 am. In the meeting Principal Dr Akhilesh Peshwe, ED Cell Incharge Dr. V. R. Kathoke, Director of i- Transform Mr. Sameer Joshi and 21 students selected for paramedic course by Maharashtra Government were present and the interaction with all the selected students was done.
