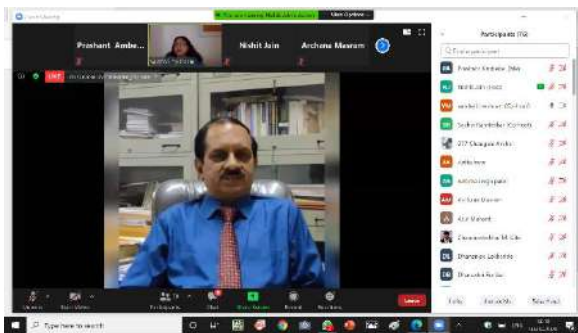


7.1.1: Measures initiated by the Institution for the promotion of gender equity during the year.
