  - d. Date of birth
  - e. Mobile Number
  - f. Email ID
  - g. Gender
  - h. Previous exam percentage
  - i. Low scoring /Failure subjects if any
  - j. Overall profile of mentee (slow learner/normal/fast learner etc).
- 2. In case more attention is needed towards any subject (mention subjects/papers/unit/topic) in view of difficulty in understanding
- 3. Disability if any
- 4. Financial background (Parent related income etc.)
- 5. Mode of travel from home to college
- 6. Specific illness if any (mention only if mentee is ready to disclose)
- 7. Expressive ability in terms of language skills (spoken/written)
- 8. Highlight specific quality of mentee if any.
- 9. Mention the problems faced/facing of mentee during
  - a. Theory period
  - b. Practical/experiment
  - c. Sports/extracurricular activities
  - d. Expressive ability and writing skill
- 10. Mention the type of Scholarship if holder of any scholarship
- 11. Mention if extra teaching is needed in specific subject
- 12. Innovative Ideas and Research
  - a. In which area the mentee is interested to pursue innovation/ research and what kind of help he/she need from the college for the same?
  - b. Any idea/design he/she wanted to work on other than study areas?
  - c. Find if he/she has worked on a specific problem he/she has faced/ pointed out and came up with its solution if any.
