Analysis & Action Taken Report of Students' Feedback 2017-2018

The students' feedback on each of the points of interest was analysed and the action taken on the suggestions is as follows

Sr. No	Suggestions recorded through online feedback	Action Taken
1	Difficult portions in the syllabus	Students mentioned the areas of difficulty in the syllabus. Heads and criteria heads were advised to take efforts to increase effectiveness of the teaching learning process in the coming sessions. Scarcity of CHB staff was a major issue from teachers' side.
