



- The Grant is Subject to the adjustment on the basis of Utilization Certificate in the prescribed proforma submitted by the University/Institution.
- The University/Institution shall maintain proper accounts of the expenditure out of the Grants which shall be utilized only on the approved items of expenditure.
- 6. The University/Institution may follow the General Financial Rules, 2005 and take urgent necessary action to amend their manuals of financial procedures to bring them in conformity with GFRs, 2005 and those don't have their own approved manuals on financial procedures may adopt the provisions of GFRs, 2005 and Instructions/guidelines there under from time to time.

- 7. The Utilization Certificate to the effect that the grant has been utilized for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned shall be furnished to UGC as early as possible after the close of current financial year.
- 8. The assets acquired wholly for substantially out of University Grants Commission's Grant shall not be disposed or encumbered or utilised for the purpose other than those for which the grants was given without proper sanction of the UGC and should at any time the University ceased to function, such assets shall revert to the University Grants Commission.
- A Register of Assets acquires wholly or subsequently out of the grant shall be maintained by the University in the prescribed proforma.
- 10. The grantee institution shall ensure the utilization of grant-in-aid for which it is being **sanctioned** / paid. In case of non-utilization/part utilization thereof, simple interest @ 10% per annum, as amended from time to time on the unutilized amount from the date of drawal to the date of refund as per provisions contained in General Financial Rules of Govt. of India, will be charged.
- 11. The University/Institution shall follow strictly the Government of India/UGC's guidelines regarding implementation of the reservation policy [both vertical (for SC, ST, & OBC) and horizontal (for persons with disability etc.)] in teaching and non-teaching posts.
- 12. The University/Institution shall fully implement the Official Language Policy of Union Government and comply with the Official Language Act, 1963 and Official Language (Use for Official Purposes of the Union) Rules, 1967 etc.
- 13. The sanction is issued in exercise of the delegation of powers vide UGC Order No. 130/2013 [F.No. 10-11/12 (Admin. IA & B)] dated 28/5/2013.
- The University/Institution shall strictly follow the UGC regulations on curbing the menace of Ragging in Higher Education Institutions, 2009.
- 15. The University/Institution shall take immediate action for its accreditation by National Assessment & Accreditation Council (NAAC).

Jamdar Siemens Center of Excellence hereinafter called the "VRJSCOE" established and operational at Visvesvaraya National Institute of Technology Nagpur, a premier technical Institution of National Importance incorporated under National Institute of Technology Act. 2007 having its permanent campus and office at Nagpur (hereafter referred to as 'VNIT Nagpur' which expression shall include its successors and assigns) of the first part;

And

**Dharampeth M. P. Deo Memorial Science College, Nagpur** hereinafter called the "**DMPDSVM**" (which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof be deemed to mean and include its successors and assigns) of the second part;

#### WHEREAS:

- 1. The Visvesvaraya National Institute of Technology Nagpur, an Institution of National Importance (formerly known as Visvesvaraya Regional Engineering College) was started as a joint and co-operative venture of the Government of India and the Government of Maharashtra in 1960 with a view to catering to the needs of man-power in technology for the country. The college has been conferred with autonomy in financial and administrative matters to achieve rapid development. Because of this rich experience, this institution was granted Deemed University Status with the approval of the UGC/AICTE and Govt. of India in the year 2003 and renamed as Visvesvaraya National Institute of Technology, thereafter.
- 2. VRJSCOE established in 2020 at VNIT Nagpur premises with investment from Siemens and VNIT Nagpur as per the Guidelines for Center of Excellence issued by Ministry of Education, Government of India. The VRJSCOE operates with a primary objective of creating a robust technical education eco-system through its experience in industrial products and services This VRJSCOE is intended to bridge gap between industry requirements and technical education, and provide solution that makes technical institutes

3. VRJSCOE has eleven Laboratories namely Design and Validation, Advanced Manufacturing. Test and Optimization, Automation, Smart Factory, Process Instrumentation, Mechatronics, CNC Machines, Robotics, IoT and Reverse Engineering through which different services are offered to Academic Institutions and Industries.

#### 4. Vision- VRJSCOE

To be a globally recognized and leading center for skill development, training and Translational research for empowering indigenous manufacturing.

#### 5. Mission - VRJSCOE

- To empower the Indian youth with industry relevant skills in manufacturing technologies by education and training securing rewarding employment opportunities
- II. To develop capabilities and building capacity for indigenous manufacturing in collaboration with industry, academia, and government agencies
- III. To provide access to state-of the art machinery and software tools for innovative design and developing new manufacturing technologies

#### 6. Details of MoU

The VRJ Siemens CoE and VNIT Nagpur, India enters into the following Agreement to offer Skill Development, Training and other related services to **DMPDSVM**, **Nagpur** 

- 1. VRJ Siemens CoE offers various skill development courses across different disciplines. **DMPDSVM**, **Nagpur** will send 100 number of students/faculty every year for such courses. The timing/duration of the courses shall be arrived on mutually agreed dates. The **VRJSCOE** offers 30% discount on the regular advertised course fee depending on the demand. In case the number of students/ faculties are less than the committed numbers on completion of a year, this may lead to reconsideration of discounts offered to the associated institute which is subjected to the review. In case the number of students/faculties are between 101-200 then **VRJSCOE** offers 35% discount on the regular advertised course fee depending on the demand.
- A student/faculty who has completed any CoE offered courses will be given 10 Hours of free Lab usage time after the course within one-year duration. The timing will be decided by the centre based on the availability.
- 3. VRJ Siemens CoE offers the resources for student projects on chargeable basis. It is the responsibility of the faculty mentor from DMPDSVM, Nagpur to monitor the progress. The VRJ Siemens CoE shall not offer any certification for such usage but shall provide an attendance certificate. The VRJSCOE offers 25% discount on the facility usage charges.

- 4. VRJ Siemens CoE offers Internships to students. The CoE can accommodate a reasonable number of students depending on the demand.
- 5. The faculty of **DMPDSVM**, **Nagpur** shall submit funding/consultancy proposals quoting the Siemens CoE resources. In such cases, a VNIT Nagpur faculty will be the Co-Pl and budgeting need to be arrived through mutual discussion before submission.
- VRJ Siemens CoE periodically conducts workshops/symposiums/conferences etc. For such events, any participant from DMPDSVM, Nagpur get 25% discount on the Registration fee.
- DMPDSVM, Nagpur shall organize events such as workshops/symposiums/conferences
  jointly with VRJSCOE in such cases, the financial implications need to be discussed and
  to be approved by competent authorities before the event.
- VRJSCOE will not be responsible for safety of the students outside the VNIT Nagpur premises. DMPDSVM, Nagpur should instruct their students clearly on the safety and precautionary measures.
- VRJSCOE will not be responsible for loss/theft or damage of any of the student's, belongings. DMPDSVM, Nagpur should instruct their students clearly on the precautionary measures.
- 10. The implementation of specific activities will be separately agreed between both institutions on need basis.
- 11. Other terms and conditions which are not provided in this Agreement will be deliberated and agreed upon by the institutions hereto.
- 12. This Agreement is established in English language and is valid from the date of signing by the representatives of the institutions. The institutions hereto have executed this Agreement in duplicate, and each institution shall keep one copy of the originals.
- 13. This agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India. Any dispute arising under these terms and conditions shall be subjected to the jurisdiction of the courts of Nagpur.
- 14. The two parties will consult each other and attempt to resolve disputes or misunderstandings that arise in the administration of this agreement informally.
- 15. This agreement shall be valid for a period of three years from the date both signatures are affixed to this document or before if terminated by mutual agreement of both. This agreement may be terminated by either party after one hundred and twenty (120) days following receipt of a written notification of intent to terminate by the other party.
